

# 4 steps to implement the Engage Series

1

Use a framework of weekly topics to organize/break down the material.

2

Pay attention to how Engage Fundamentals aligns with your content area/topics ("Everything was right there that I needed," Dr. B said.), and use it to strengthen clinical judgment skills.

3

Create a new digital folder each week in which to post resources (PowerPoints, discussion questions, case studies) and phase out textbook resources. ("It was a lot of work up front, but now it's done," she noted.)

4

Use concept mapping to work through issues collaboratively, especially for early students.
