4 STRATEGIES FOR LISTENING EFFECTIVELY TO GEN Z STUDENTS

LISTEN ATTENTIVELY. Face the student and make eye contact, use appropriate facial gestures, and avoid fidgeting.



LISTEN QUIETLY.

Be comfortable with silence and allow the student to finish a thought without interrupting, prejudging, or preparing your response.



LISTEN FOR WHAT IS NOT SAID. Consider what needs/barriers/ motivations that the student is

not explicitly communicating.



LISTEN WITH INTENT. Be prepared to ask supportive questions.

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
