Use the polling tool to keep students focused and collect responses to questions.

Use Zoom breakout rooms
to split your class into smaller groups.

As the instructor, you can visit the breakout rooms, broadcast messages to various rooms, and end the breakout sessions when it is time to regroup.

Use the Whiteboard tool for interactive annotations.

Select the Whiteboard tool after you share your screen. Then, ask students to annotate with notes, drawings, highlighting, etc., throughout your presentation.

Pro tip: Save as a PNG or PDF to share in your LMS or email to students later.

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
